A reminder about results

Exam results will be published on Thursday 20th August. These will be sent to you remotely, as an attachment sent to your school email address in the morning (approx. 8am). Your teachers are not allowed to discuss your calculated grade with you and you should not ask for any information in relation to it. We will also issue a survey via Microsoft Forms, for anyone not joining our sixth form, to tell us where and what you are studying next (essential for us and the Local Authority to know this so you can be supported in the future).
