## Printing at School

- You can walk up to any of the following printers and use the touchscreen to log in using either your Printing ID number or your Username and password (using the ID number is a LOT quicker!):


Printers are:
ICT corridor (next to Textiles)
Learning Hub
Science block

Every page you print costs money and trees! You have been assigned credit on your account. When this reaches zero, you will not be able to print anything or copy anything.

- The charges for printing and copying are:

$$
\begin{aligned}
& \text { Black and white }-1.1 \text { p per A4 page } \\
& \text { Colour }-5 \text { p per A4 page }
\end{aligned}
$$

A page means one side of a sheet of paper.
A3 (twice the size of A4) will cost an additional 1p per page (black and white or colour).

Remember the following to make best use of your credit:

- Use PrintQ Mono by default. Don’t send printing to PrintQ Colour unless you want colour! Even black and white documents will be charged 5 p per page if sent to the colour queue!
- If you can print things double-sided - do it - use both sides of the sheet. It's slightly cheaper (you get a 10\% discount!) and it saves paper and trees. In Word and PowerPoint this looks like
