Dear Parent/Carer,

As we reach the end of the school year, we understand that students can grow meaning that some items of their uniform may not fit as well as they did at the start of the year.

We have noticed an increasing number of students wearing very short skirts, which is not appropriate in a school setting and are aware that this is due to students outgrowing their current uniform. For students who have experienced a growth spurt, we can apply a little tolerance but in some cases what we are seeing is excessive and sets the wrong tone.

Unfortunately, there is a growing trend of rolling skirts up at the waist. We would appreciate your support in combatting this. Please note that the hem of the skirt should be within 5cm from the top of the knee. Please can you support the school by having conversations about not rolling up skirts. We have found that some parents have questioned uniform logs as they send their child out the house with an appropriate length skirt – thank you for this.

We will be checking skirt length to ensure they are sensible but also checking that the vent is at the back – some students have put the vent to the side to make it easier to roll up. Continued breaching of the uniform policy in this way will be sanctioned.

Looking ahead to the new Academic year, please see the below guide for acceptable skirts. Please ensure you are purchasing the right skirt when buying new uniform. Incorrect uniform will result in sanctions in September:

Skirt

- Navy blue with back vent or navy blue with all round pleats.
- Material containing a polyester and viscose mix has been selected.
- Fitted and/or Lycra skirts are **NOT** allowed.
- Skirt should be no more than 5cm above the knee

Whilst the skirt images below may look black, students **must wear navy skirts.**
