Using Unifrog, we suggest that students complete the following tasks each day:-

1. Complete a careers profile using the careers library tool. It should include key information like entry requirements, salary, working conditions, career progression.
2. Complete a university or apprenticeship shortlist.
3. Watch and summarise a past webinar using the webinars tool.
4. One activity from the 'read, watch, listen' tool.

In addition, they can also complete the following tasks throughout the 2 weeks:-

1. Work environments profile
2. Interests profile
3. Personality profile
4. Skills profile
