Breakfast Club trial

At KNGS, we recognise the importance of a good breakfast, but we also recognise that mornings in our homes can be extremely busy and sometimes, breakfast is missed because of this.

In order to support our students so that they are ready for a busy day of learning, we are trialling a Breakfast Club from Monday 25th September which will run up to and including Friday 22nd December 2023 to see if this offer proves popular to our families.

Breakfast Club will run from 8-8.25am (8.20-8.45am on Thursdays) in the KNGS canteen. Students will be able to pay for their breakfast in the normal way (biometrics or PIN number) through our ParentPay facility. There is no need to sign up for Breakfast Club, just be at the front entrance to the school by 8am so that the Supervisors can take all students down to the canteen. We will not be able to accept late arrivals due to health and safety reasons at that time in the morning related to the limited numbers of staff on site and fire safety measures. Students will be expected to remain in the canteen until 8.25am when they can head to their form group to be registered, they will not be allowed to move around the school until then.

To give you a 'taste' of what will be on offer, we are working closely with our catering partner Academy to provide a selection of hot and cold options and a menu that could include the following:

- Porridge Pots
- Yogurt & Granola
- Bacon Roll
- Cheese on Toast
- Muffins
- Crumpets
- Breakfast Frittatas
- Fruit Pot
- Roasted vegetable turnover
- Croissant

For our students in receipt of Free School Meals, we will be providing a £1 allowance per day to go towards some breakfast during the trial period. This will be in addition to the main FSM and will only be available to use at breakfast time.
