Kings Norton Girls' School & Sixth Form enjoyed excellent results in both GCSE and A Levels in 2023:

GCSE Results 2023

- 38% of grades were 7+, 16% above national
- 76% of grades were 5+, 24% above national
- 89% of grades at 4+, 21% above national

A Level Results 2023

In 2023 we saw fantastic A Level results with:

- A*-A : one third of grades
- A*-B : two thirds of grades

In 2023 our students progressed to high quality destinations; they were successful with applications to Russell Group universities, Oxbridge, an increasing number of apprenticeships, conservatoire, many other top universities and carefully planned gap years.
