We will welcome Loudmouth back at the beginning of the day and watch their performance that covers themes such as teenage partner/domestic abuse and consent.

The following workshops will be delivered on the day:

- Relationships and Sex Education - This session will educate the students about the use of contraception and they will learn about STI's. They will also explore the emotional element involved in sex and relationships and how to deal with some of these, including consent.
- Teen abuse in relationships – students will explore what abuse is. They will learn about key terms relating to abuse, the impact it might have on someone and consider ways to find help in situations where abuse is present.
- Knife crime – this session will look at the very topical issue of knife crime and safety.
- Extremism and radicalisation – this session will educate students about what extremism is and what can be involved in the radicalisation process, therefore knowing how to prevent themselves from being susceptible to radicalisation.
- Importance of Happiness – this session will explore what happiness is and give students opportunity to consider what they value and what can contribute to our happiness.
