Kings Norton Girls' School & Sixth Form enjoyed excellent results in both GCSE and A Levels in 2025:

GCSE Results 2025

- 37% of grades were 7+, 15% above national
- 74% of grades were 5+, 22% above national
- 86% of grades at 4+, 19% above national

A Level Results 2025

In 2025 we saw fantastic A Level results with:

- A*-A : 30.4% of grades
- A*-B : 59.4% of grades
- Average grade: B-
